Healthcare organizations have access to more data than ever before but often lack the actionable insights required for improvement. Organizations that want to improve performance must translate data into knowledge and integrate cutting-edge analytics into daily operations.¹

IMPROVED PERFORMANCE REQUIRES MORE THAN VAST DATA

INTEGRIS Health had a healthcare benchmarking tool, but the tool failed to transform data into knowledge that could be used to improve operations and outcomes. Data latency of up to one year for value-based care measures limited the organization's ability to make data-informed decisions.

Touchstone is a benchmarking asset that uses artificial intelligence to proactively identify where an organization is performing well and where it is underperforming so that organizations can prioritize and drive towards improvement.

INTEGRIS Health uses the risk-adjusted benchmarks to understand performance both within the organization and relative to its peers, perform opportunity analyses, establish improvement priorities, allocate resources, and drive improvement targets in its daily operations. The organization uses the scoring system in Touchstone to compare the INTEGRIS Health system and each of its 11 hospitals to similar-type organizations and customized cohorts.

The organization now has integrated data, analytics, and machine learning-driven algorithms to identify real opportunities to improve value-based care-measure performance, patient safety, and mortality. For the first time, INTEGRIS Health has access to timely, actionable data to address quality issues. Effective healthcare benchmarking has revealed strengths and opportunities and uncovered some surprising insights. For example, heart failure readmissions had been a high-priority target for improvement, but INTEGRIS Health performed well compared to peer benchmarks. In contrast, sepsis readmissions had been overlooked and have now become a focus.
